

Larchmont YC Sailors Compete At Acura Miami Grand Prix (story continued)

Those who trekked to this international event (once known as the legendary SORC) experienced wind and waves strong enough to delaminate the hulls of grand prix racers and damaging lightning strikes, before more moderate breezes ended the ten race regatta.

In the twenty boat Melges 32 class, Argo, owned and helmed by Larchmont YC's Jason Carroll, parlayed four top three finishes to a fourth place overall in the Acura Miami Grand Prix and a fourth place finish in the Acura Grand Prix Championship (which combines scores from Key West Race Week and the Acura Miami Grand Prix). The Acura Miami Grand Prix was just the fourth class event entered by Carroll's team, which includes Sean Doyle (tactics), Pete Strothman (main trim), Sam Rogers (jib and spinnaker trim), Kai Cox (mast), Clay Bischoff (pit, tactics), Patrick Mauro (mast) and Brian Fox (bow).
