

Markus Edegran was the top American at Lake Garda, finishing 26th out of 825 boats in one of the largest one-design regattas ever held, with many countries sending their top sailors as a tune up for the Optimist Europeans.

In Holland, Reinier Eenkema van Dijk finished 23rd out of 214 sailors, starting the regatta with two straight bullets. Matthew Mollerus overcame a slow start to end his series with two straight bullets en route to a 4th place finish in the bronze fleet. This was the coldest Easter Regatta in forty years, with sailors enduring snow, sleet and gale force winds.

At the South American Championship, Andrew Mollerus rebounded from two OCSs in the 190-boat fleet to finish 96th overall against the Western Hemisphere's best, including two top ten finishes.
