HOUSING INFORMATION**

PLEASE DISTRIBUTE TO ALL PARTICIPANTS AND INSTRUCTORS.

Housing will be provided for Junior Race Week participants from the following clubs: Black Rock, Cedar Point, Centerport, Cold Spring Harbor, Fishers Island, Groton Long Point, Head of The Bay, Huntington, Milford, Niantic, Northport, Pequot, Pettipaug, Pine Orchard, Ram Island, Seawanhaka and Shelter Island.

HOUSING APPLICATION DEADLINE: Housing requests should be submitted on the Housing Request Form posted on www.larchmontyc.org. Once completed, this form should be saved as an attachment and sent via e-mail to LYChousing@gmail.com **NO LATER THAN 1800 Tuesday July 6, 2010.**

Clubs will be accommodated on a first come, first serve basis. Housing, which will be in members' homes, will be available for up to 11 sailors per club and their accompanying instructor. No one under 12 years of age will be housed.

NO EXCEPTIONS.

IMPORTANT: Any requests for sailors to be housed together should be made on the club's housing request form. The Housing Committee will make every attempt to accommodate requests so made. Changes cannot be made after housing has been assigned.

CRUISING BOAT ACCOMMODATIONS: Clubs that wish to accommodate participants on cruising boats, must supply the LYC Junior Sailing Committee with the name of the yacht, the name of the instructor or other adult in charge { who must sleep on board) and a list of the sailors staying on board **NO LATER THAN MONDAY MORNING, JULY 12, 2010.** See General Condition's sheet for all requirements regarding cruising boats during Junior Race Week.

INSTRUCTOR RESPONSIBILITIES: Any club requesting housing is expected to have one senior instructor staying locally who will be responsible for the entire group throughout the regatta, both during the day and at night. Housing and complimentary lunch, dinner and dance tickets for the evenings will be provided for the instructor. The instructor must attend all scheduled social functions.

Instructors are expected to observe "curfews" and the same house rules that apply to participants. If an instructor fails to comply, he/she will be subject to disciplinary action.

PARTICIPANT RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Monday morning, all sailors must check in as soon as possible to receive housing assignments.
- Monday evening, all sailors must report to the Housing Desk promptly at 7:00 p.m. to meet their hostesses.

The host families will provide their guests with breakfast on Tuesday and Wednesday. All entrants who are being housed **MUST ATTEND** the scheduled evening dinners and activities at the Club or, if the host family consents, remain at the host family's home Those sailors participating in Junior Race Week who are not being housed are welcome to attend the dinners and dance. The regatta entry fee includes the cost of these activities. No reciprocal club signing will be allowed. Any incidental expenses must be paid in cash.

Each sailor is expected to abide by the "house rules" set by his/her host family. All those being housed must be back in their homes **ONE HALF HOUR** after the evening's Club-scheduled entertainment has ended. **ANYONE NOT COMPLYING WITH THIS REQUIREMENT WILL BE SUBJECT TO DISQUALIFICATION FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE REGATTA.**

The Larchmont Yacht Club, in accordance with the JSA of L.I.S. Rules, will disqualify and send home any participant, skipper or crew, for destruction of property or other unseemly conduct. Drinking and other illegal behavior by any participant at any time or in any place is prohibited. Any infraction will result in immediate disqualification and the sailor will be sent home. In addition, any violation on the part of a sailor may result in that sailor's club being denied housing next year.
