Second Amendment to the 2011 YRA LIS Mid-Sound One-Design Sailing Instructions

6 CLASS FLAGS

Classes are numbered as shown in the YRALIS instructions except as modified below and may not be started in sequence: 6-505s, 7-RK6s, 8-Windmills

9 THE COURSE

The race committee may elect to give Class 6 (505) and Class 7 (RK6) & Class 8 (Windmill) a substantially shorter windward leg than is posted for the other classes. If it does so, it will announce its intentions by loudhailer and will post "S" on the signal board next to Classes 6, 7 & 8, signifying a shorter windward leg for those Classes.

10 MARKS

If the race committee elects to give Class 6, 7 & 8 a shorter windward leg, it will use a white inflatable as the windward mark for those Classes. This will not be a mark of the course for Classes 1 – 5. A new mark, as per instruction 13, Changing the next leg of course, will be the same white mark.
