NOTICE OF REGATTA

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined by *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008 (RRS)*.
- 1.2 Part 5 Section B is changed to provide for arbitration of protests of Part 2 rules.

2 ENTRIES & FEES

- 2.1 All eligible boats may enter by registering on approved entry forms received by the Larchmont Yacht Club front desk not later than 1200, Saturday, June 16, 2007 or on line at: www.larchmontyc.org
- 2.2 All entries not submitted on line shall be mailed to the Larchmont Yacht Club, 1 Woodbine Ave., Larchmont, NY 10538. Telephone: 914-834-2440. Faxed entries will be accepted only with a valid signature for credit card authorization. Fax: 914-468-7751.
- 2.3 The entry fee for this regatta is \$80.00. Entry fee includes BBQ dinner for 2. Extra BBQ tickets available for \$25.00 each.

5 COURSES

Courses will be a triangle, windward-leeward or Harry Anderson as described in the sailing instructions.

6 RACE AREA

The racing area will be in the waters off the breakwater of Larchmont Harbor.

7 SCORING

7.1 One completed race will constitute a series.

7.2 The Race Committee intends to run multiple races. If fewer than 6 races are completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. If 6 or more races are completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score subject to rule 89.3(b).

8 PRIZES

8.1 Prizes will be awarded following the conclusion of racing on Sunday, June 17.

8.2 Prizes will be awarded for first, second and third place finishers.

9 CONDUCT AND RESPONSIBILITY

9.1 The skipper/owner shall be responsible for all actions of his or her crew or guests. In the event of a breach of conduct, sportsmanship, destruction of property, or failure to comply with the request of any race officer, committee member or agent of the Larchmont Yacht Club, the skipper/owner will be held responsible and his/her boat shall be subject to protest and disqualification.

9.2 The Larchmont Yacht Club is not responsible and will not accept any liability for bodily injury, death or property damage suffered from any cause. Each participant, including skipper and crew, participates in the regatta entirely at his/her own risk and waives any and all claims, including those arising from negligence or lack of due care, which he/she may have against the Larchmont Yacht Club, its regatta committee, and its officers, trustees, committee members, members, agents, or employees. Responsibility for evaluating the wind, sea and weather conditions rests with each participant as does responsibility for the safe condition of the boat, including safety equipment and rigging and for deciding when to wear life jackets. Patrol boats or other assistance will not likely be available. Assistance, if any, from the regatta committee or other Larchmont Yacht Club vessels, or other patrol boats, from any personnel manning them, is entirely at the risk of the participant.
