### NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Appendix V1, Penalty at the Time of an Incident, will apply.

#### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Viper, Etchells, IOD, Shields, S-Boat, classes. To qualify as a class for this regatta, three valid entries of that class must be received prior to 1200, Friday, May 24. Additional classes may be added provided they meet the minimum number of entries.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by registering on line at [www.larchmontyc.org](http://www.larchmontyc.org) and submitted no later than 1100, Sat., May 25, 2019.
- 2.3 There is no entry fee for this regatta.

#### 3 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Saturday, May 25: 1425 First Warning  
Sunday, May 26: 1425 First Warning

Awards following the completion of racing on May 26 on the front lawn of the Club.

#### 4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The 2019 YRALIS Mid-Sound One-Design Sailing Instructions will apply. Amendments, if any, to those sailing instructions will be posted no later than 1800 Friday, May 24 on the website <https://www.larchmontyc.org>, and on the official notice board located on the front porch of the main clubhouse.

#### 5 VENUE

The racing area will be off Larchmont Harbor.

#### 6 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be as stated in the YRA of LIS Sailing Instructions.

#### 7 PROTESTS

- 7.1 A boat intending to protest for an incident while racing shall notify the race committee promptly upon finishing the race.
- 7.2 Protest forms are available at the front desk.
- 7.3 Written protests shall be delivered to the protest desk located on the second floor of the clubhouse.
- 7.4 The protest time limit is one hour after the race committee comes ashore and will be posted on the notice board located on the veranda.
- 7.5 A list of protests filed at the protest desk will be posted on the veranda notice board.
- 7.6 Hearings will begin as soon as practicable after written protests are filed. Witnesses must be available when called. If they do not appear when called, they may not be heard.

#### 8 SCORING

- 8.1 One completed race will constitute a series.
- 8.2 The Race Committee intends to run multiple races. When fewer than five races are completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When five or more races are completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## 9 SUPPORT BOATS

Coaches and other support boat personnel shall not be in the racing area from the time of the first warning signal for the first division until all boats have finished or the regatta committee signals a postponement or abandonment.

## 10 RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 10.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communications that is not available to all boats.
- 10.2 Each boat shall carry a VHF radio capable of receiving and transmitting on all standard VHF channels. The regatta VHF channel will be 78A or 1078

## 11 PRIZES

Series prizes will be awarded for classes that qualify in NOR 2.1. Prizes will be awarded to first, second and third place boats.

## 12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

By registering for this event, the owner and person-in-charge of the boat agree with the following:

- 1) My crew and I recognize that sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury associated with it. We have read rule 4, Decision to Race, and hereby acknowledge and agree that we are participating in this event entirely at our own risk.
- 2) I acknowledge and agree that neither the organizing authority nor the race committee, nor their members will be responsible for:
  - a) any damage to the entered boat or my other property, or
  - b) any injury to my crew or me, including death, sustained as a result of our participation in this event.
- 3) I hereby waive any rights I may have to sue the race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors or any other organization or official) with respect to personal injury or property damage suffered by my crew or me as a result of our participation in this event, whether on the water or on shore, and hereby release the race organizers from any liability for such injury or damage to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- 4) I have taken all necessary steps to ensure that my crew and I and my entered boat are adequately prepared for all possible contingencies, including carrying and using appropriate safety equipment as may be required by law, racing rules and that a prudent seaman would consider advisable.

**I agree to be bound by all rules that govern this event. I will inform all crewmembers of the conditions stated herein for their participation in such racing.**
