NOTICE OF REGATTA

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*
- 1.2 RRS 40 Personal Flotation is changed to read: "Each competitor shall wear a non-inflatable, USCG approved personal flotation of the appropriate size for the sailor, at all times while on the water, except for brief periods while adding or removing clothing. This also changes the Preamble to Part 4
- 1.3 Appendix V1 Penalty at the Time of the Incident will apply.

2 REGATTA FORMAT

- 2.1 The regatta is a "collegiate style" event.
- 2.2 Each team shall be sailed by "A" and "B" divisions consisting of separate skippers and crews. No skipper or crew may sail in both divisions without prior approval by the race committee.
- 2.3 Each team shall use the same boat and sails for both divisions.
- 2.4 Each division will sail between two to four races followed by a short intermission to allow for the divisions to switch.

3 ENTRY & FEES

- 3.1 The regatta will be sailed in Vanguard 15 Class boats. All eligible teams may enter by registering on line at: <https://larchmontyachtclub.org> no than 1100, Saturday, June 15, 2019.
- 3.2 The entry fee is \$160.00. Entry fee includes dinner for 4 and keg beer. Entry fees are payable to the Larchmont Yacht Club. Extra dinner tickets are \$25.00 per person.

6 COURSES

7 RACE AREA

The racing area will be in the waters off of Larchmont Harbor.

8 SCORING

8.1 One completed race per division will constitute a series.

8.2 Each division will be scored separately and the overall score will be the sum of all races for the two divisions. Each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores without exclusion.

9 PRIZES

9.1 Prizes will be awarded following the conclusion of racing on Sunday, June 16.

9.2 Prizes will be awarded for first, second and third place overall teams

10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

By registering for this event, the owner and person-in-charge of the boat agree with the following:

1) My crew and I recognize that sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury associated with it. We have read rule 4, Decision to Race, and hereby acknowledge and agree that we are participating in this event entirely at our own risk.

2) I acknowledge and agree that neither the organizing authority nor the race committee, nor their members will be responsible for:

a) any damage to the entered boat or my other property, or

b) any injury to my crew or me, including death, sustained as a result of our participation in this event.

3) I hereby waive any rights I may have to sue the race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors or any other organization or official) with respect to personal injury or property damage suffered by my crew or me as a result of our participation in this event, whether on the water or on shore, and hereby release the race organizers from any liability for such injury or damage to the fullest extent permitted by law.

4) I have taken all necessary steps to ensure that my crew and I and my entered boat are adequately prepared for all possible contingencies, including carrying and using appropriate safety equipment as may be required by law, racing rules and that a prudent seaman would consider advisable.

I agree to be bound by all rules that govern this event. I will inform all crewmembers of the conditions stated herein for their participation in such racing.
