NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Rule V, Alternative Penalties, will apply

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The 2021 YRA Mid-Sound One Design Sailing instructions will apply. Amendments, if any, to those sailing instructions will be posted no later than 1800 Friday, May 28, on the website <https://www.larchmontyc.org>, and the Google group page.

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on the veranda of the main clubhouse of the Larchmont Yacht Club and on the YRA Mid-Sound Google group page at <https://groups.google.com/g/yra-mid-sound-one-design>
- 3.2 Each boat shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on VHF 78A
- 3.3 On the water, the race committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio.
- 3.4 [DP] While racing, from the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats of the Viper 640, Etchells, International One Design, Shields, and S-Class.
- 4.2 Eligible boats may enter by registering online at https://larchmontyachtclub.formstack.com/forms/2021_memorial_day
- 4.3 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements.
- 4.4 To qualify as a class for this regatta, three valid entries of that class must be received prior to 1200, Wednesday, May 26.

5 FEES

There is no entry fee for this event.

6 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Awards following the completion of racing on May 30 on the front lawn of the Larchmont Yacht Club.

7 VENUE

The starting area will be in the waters east of the Larchmont breakwater.

8 COURSES

The course(s) to be sailed will be windward/leeward or triangle as described in the sailing instructions.

9 SCORING

- 9.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.2 When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10 PRIZES

Series prizes will be awarded for classes that qualify in NoR 4.4. Prizes will be awarded to first, second, and third-place boats following the completion of racing Sunday, May 30 on the front lawn.

11 COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

Skippers and crews shall comply with the Club's current Covid-19 protocols, as posted on the Club's website. A breach of this rule shall not be grounds for a protest by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a)

12 RISK STATEMENT

By registering for this event, the person in charge of each boat agrees with the following:

- 1) My crew and I recognize that sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury, sickness, and disease (including communicable diseases such as Covid-19) associated with it. We have read RRS 3, Decision to Race, and hereby acknowledge and agree that we are participating in this event entirely at our own risk.
- 2) I acknowledge and agree that neither the organizing authority, host club nor the race committee, nor their members will be responsible for: a) any damage to the entered boat or my other property, or b) any injury, sickness, or disease (including communicable diseases such as Covid-19) to my crew or me, including death, sustained as a result of our participation in this event.
- 3) I hereby waive any rights I may have to sue the race organizers (organizing authority, host club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors, or any other organization or official) with respect to personal injury, sickness, or disease (including communicable diseases such as Covid-19) or property damage suffered by my crew or me as a result of our participation in this event, whether on the water or onshore, and hereby release the race organizers from any liability for such injury, sickness or disease (including communicable diseases such as Covid-19) or damage to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- 4) I have taken all necessary steps to ensure that my crew and I and my entered boat are adequately prepared for all possible contingencies, including carrying and using appropriate safety equipment as may be required by law, racing rules and that a prudent seaman would consider advisable.

I agree to be bound by all rules that govern this event.

I will inform all crewmembers of the conditions stated herein for their participation in such racing
