2 CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The 2022 YRA Mid-Sound One Design Sailing Instructions will apply. Amendments, if any, to those sailing instructions will be posted no later than 1800 Friday, May 27, on the the official notice board and may also be posted on the club website <https://www.larchmontyc.org>, and emailed through the Google group page.

3 COMMUNICATION

3.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on the veranda of the main clubhouse of the Larchmont Yacht Club and may also be on the YRA Mid-Sound Google group page at <https://groups.google.com/g/yra-mid-sound-one-design>

3.2 Each boat shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on VHF 78A

3.3 On the water, the race committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors via the VHF radio.

3.4 [DP] While racing, from the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

14 HEARING REQUESTS

14.1 Rule 61.1(a) is changed, add: Immediately after finishing, a protesting boat shall notify the race committee of her intent to lodge a protest and the identity of the boat she intends to protest.

14.2 The protest time limit is 60 minutes after the finish race committee comes ashore. This time limit will be posted on the official notice board located on the veranda.

14.3 Notice of hearings will be posted on the official notice board as soon as possible after the protest time limit has expired.

14.4 Notices of protests by the race committee or protest committee will be posted on the official notice board to inform boats under RRS 61.1(b).

14. Hearings will begin as soon as practicable after protest forms are filed.

15 SCORING

- 15.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 15.2 For the YRA Mid Sound One Design Fleets, when fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 15.3 For the Ocean – Great Lakes Challenge Cup, a maximum of 7 races are scheduled. A boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores. Practice races will not be included.

19 PRIZES

- 19.1 For the YRA Mid Sound One Design Fleets - Series prizes will be awarded for classes that qualify in NoR 4. Prizes will be awarded to first, second, and third-place boats following the completion of racing Sunday, May 29 on the front lawn.
- 19.2 The Ocean-Great Lakes Challenge Cup Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the overall winner. Keeper trophies will be awarded to each member of the top finishing boat. The Perpetual Trophy will remain at the Chicago Yacht Club
