NOTICE OF RACE

[DP] The notation '[DP]' in a *rule* means that the penalty for a breach of the *rule* may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The current PHRF Regulations as administered by the YRA of LIS will apply.
- 1.3 Boats shall observe the current US Sailing Special Equipment Requirements for Nearshore races, however section 2 and 3 shall not apply to boats not designed and equipped with: pulpits, stanchions, lifelines or self-bailing cockpits.
- 1.4 Rule V, Alternative Penalties, will apply.
- 1.5 Appendix T will apply as changed below:

After the last sentence of appendix T4, Arbitration Meeting Outcomes, add the following: If a protest hearing is held, the arbitrator will not be a member of the panel that hears the protest but will be permitted to observe the testimony presented and offer evidence. This changes rule T4 and rule 63.3(a).

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 Sailing instructions will be available on the Larchmont Yacht Club site at: <u>https://www.larchmontyc.org</u> and on <u>yachtscoring.com</u> no later than 1800, Wednesday, July 17, 2024. Copies will also be available during the event at the hospitality desk.
- 2.2 Scratch sheets will be available on Yacht Scoring.com no later than 1200, July 19, 2024.

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located online at <u>vachtscoring.com</u>
- 3.2 Each boat shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on VHF channel 73.
- 3.3 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors via VHF.
- 3.4 [DP] While racing, from the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to Offshore One Designs, Racer-Cruisers and Non-Spinnaker Boats. For those classes not sailing One-Design under class rules, entries shall be accompanied by a valid YRALIS PHRF certificate.
- 4.2 For Non Spinnaker boats, a minimum of 5 entries shall be received by 1700, Wednesday, July 10, 2024 for a separate start.
- 4.3 Eligible boats may enter by registering online at <u>yachtscoring.com</u> no later than 1700 Wednesday, July 10, 2024.
- 4.4 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

5 FEES

The entry fee is \$50.00 if paid before 1700, Friday, June 21, 2024. The entry fee is \$75.00 if paid after 1700, Friday, June 21, 2024. The entry fee includes awards and beer following the completion of racing.

6 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

7 VENUE

The starting area will be in the waters off Larchmont Harbor

8 COURSES

The course for all Divisions is around Execution Rocks and return as described in the sailing instructions.

9 SCORING

- 9.1 PHRF, time allowances will be computed using Time on Distance.
- 9.2 Rule A5.3 applies.

10 PRIZES

- 10.1 Awards will be given for the best elapsed time and as well as first, second and third for best corrected time.
- 10.2 A boat which sets a new elapsed time long course record in the Execution Rocks Race will receive a case of
 - Mt. Gay Rum. The elapsed time record for the long course is 1:00:48, set by Sundari on July 21, 2019.
- 10.3 Prizes will be awarded following the completion of Race Week, Sunday, July 21, 2024.

11 GUEST MOORING AND PRIVILEGES

Guest moorings will be available on a first-come basis at no charge through Dockwa.

12 RISK STATEMENT

By registering for this event, the person-in-charge of each boat agrees with the following:

1) My crew and I recognize that sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury, sickness, and disease (including communicable diseases such as Covid-19) associated with it. We have read RRS 3, Decision to Race, and hereby acknowledge and agree that we are participating in this event entirely at our own risk.

2) I acknowledge and agree that neither the organizing authority, host club nor the race committee, nor their members will be responsible for: a) any damage to the entered boat or my other property, or b) any injury, sickness or disease (including communicable diseases such as Covid-19) to my crew or me, including death, sustained as a result of our participation in this event.

3) I hereby waive any rights I may have to sue the race organizers (organizing authority, host club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors or any other organization or official) with respect to personal injury, sickness or disease (including communicable diseases such as Covid-19) or property damage suffered by my crew or me as a result of our participation in this event, whether on the water or on shore, and hereby release the race organizers from any liability for such injury, sickness or disease (including communicable diseases such as Covid-19) or damage to the fullest extent permitted by law.

4) I have taken all necessary steps to ensure that my crew and I and my entered boat are adequately prepared for all possible contingencies, including carrying and using appropriate safety equipment as may be required by law, racing rules and that a prudent seaman would consider advisable.

I agree to be bound by all rules that govern this event.

I will inform all crewmembers of the conditions stated herein for their participation in such racing
