NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Appendix V1, Penalty at the Time of an Incident, will apply.
- 1.3 RRS 40.1 PERSONAL FLOATATION DEVICES will apply.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available on the Larchmont Yacht Club site at: <https://www.larchmontyc.org> and on [Yachtscoring.com](https://www.yachtscoring.com), no later than 1800 Friday, July 17, 2024. Copies will also be available at the Race Week Hospitality desk.

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on the veranda of the main clubhouse.
- 3.2 Each boat shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on VHF channel 05.
- 3.3 On the water, the race committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio.
- 3.4 While racing, from the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats of the Ideal 18 class.
- 4.2 Eligible boats may enter by registering online at [Yachtscoring.com](https://www.yachtscoring.com)
- 4.3 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- 4.4 Teams of at least 2 yachts, in separate classes (racer/cruiser, navigator, one design) along with at least 1 Team Race entry, will be eligible for the Larchmont Race Week Club Champion Trophy.

5 FEES

The entry fee is \$150.00 for entries received before 1800 Friday, June 21, 2024. For entries received after June 21, the entry fee is \$195.00 and includes live music ashore, beer and awards following racing.

6 CHARTERED BOATS

- 6.1 It is expected that most of the boats sailing in this event will be owned by skippers' yacht clubs. Skippers are encouraged to arrange to sail boats owned by their clubs.
- 6.2 For skippers who are unable to arrange boats owned by their clubs, the OA and other area yacht clubs will make their Ideal 18s available for charter on a first-come basis. Boat charter must be selected during online registration. Please see the separate Boat Charter Document posted on the Notice board.
- 6.3 Boat charters will be managed by the OA. Participants will be notified of the boat they will sail at registration. Chartered boats are provided "as is" and will include sails and all required safety equipment. Charterers are encouraged to provide their own sails and to inspect their boats prior to sailing to determine if they wish to add any spare or extra gear.
- 6.4 An additional Waiver form regarding personal injury and chartered boat responsibility must be signed at registration.
- 6.5 Competitors are responsible for ensuring their boats are in shipshape condition each day after racing.

8 VENUE

The racing area will be in the waters off Larchmont Harbor

9 COURSES

The course(s) to be sailed will be windward/leeward, as described in the sailing instructions.

10 SCORING

- 10.1 One completed race will constitute a regatta.
- 10.2 If fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. If five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 10.3 For the Larchmont Race Week Champion Trophy, teams will be scored by using the average percentage of their team race score plus their top two team members' percentage placement within their respective classes.

11 PRIZES

- 11.1 Prizes will be awarded to first, second, and third place boats following the completion of racing on the front lawn, Sunday, July 21, 2024.
- 11.2 The Larchmont Race Week Club Championship Trophy will be awarded to the club with the top club team score following the completion of racing on Sunday, July 21, 2024.

12 RISK STATEMENT

By registering for this event, the person-in-charge of each boat agrees with the following:

- 1) My crew and I recognize that sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury, sickness, and disease (including communicable diseases such as Covid-19) associated with it. We have read RRS 3, Decision to Race, and hereby acknowledge and agree that we are participating in this event entirely at our own risk.
- 2) I acknowledge and agree that neither the organizing authority, host club nor the race committee, nor their members will be responsible for: a) any damage to the entered boat or my other property, or b) any injury, sickness or disease (including communicable diseases such as Covid-19) to my crew or me, including death, sustained as a result of our participation in this event.
- 3) I hereby waive any rights I may have to sue the race organizers (organizing authority, host club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors or any other organization or official) with respect to personal injury, sickness or disease (including communicable diseases such as Covid-19) or property damage suffered by my crew or me as a result of our participation in this event, whether on the water or on shore, and hereby release the race organizers from any liability for such injury, sickness or disease (including communicable diseases such as Covid-19) or damage to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- 4) I have taken all necessary steps to ensure that my crew and I and my entered boat are adequately prepared for all possible contingencies, including carrying and using appropriate safety equipment as may be required by law, racing rules and that a prudent seaman would consider advisable.

I agree to be bound by all rules that govern this event.

I will inform all crewmembers of the conditions stated herein for their participation in such racing
