### Supplemental Sailing Instructions

#### **2 CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS & COMMUNICATION**

- 2.1 Any changes to the sailing instructions will be posted no later than 1100 on the day they will take effect.
- 2.2 Oral Changes may be made on the water via loudhailer and acknowledged by each participant.
- 2.2 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on the veranda of the main clubhouse.
- 2.3 Each boat may carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on VHF 05A
- 2.4 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio and loudhailer. The channel will be stated in the Sis
- 2.5 [DP] While racing, From the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

#### **4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE**

- 4.1 Signals made ashore will not apply.

#### **5. SCHEDULE OF RACES**

- 5.1 First Warning will be at 1300 on the following Saturdays:  
May 8-29, June 5, 26, July 3, 24, 31, August 14, 21, 28, September 4, and 11
- 5.2 No warning signal after 1500

#### **6. CLASS FLAGS**

The starting sequence will be announced prior to the warning signal for each race.

#### **7. THE COURSES**

The courses to be sailed will be announced by the race committee via loudhailer from the signal vessel.

#### **8 MARKS**

- 8.1 Original rounding marks will be orange hippity hops
- 8.2 Change marks will be yellow hippity hops

#### **9 THE START**

- 9.1 Races will be started using Appendix U Audible Sound System
- 9.2 The starting marks will be a staff displaying an orange flag on the port end and staff displaying an orange flag on the signal vessel.

#### **11. THE FINISH**

The finishing line will be between a staff displaying a yellow flag on the signal vessel and the course-side staff displaying a yellow flag on the starboard end. This changes Race Signals

#### **12. TIME LIMITS**

- 12.1 Time limit for the first boat to start, sail the course, and finish is 45 minutes
- 12.2 Boats not finishing within 15 minutes of the first boat in its class will be scored TLE without a hearing. Boats scored TLE will be scored the number of finishers plus 2 This changes RRS 35, A4, and A5.

#### **14 SAFETY REGULATIONS**

- 14.1 All skippers should pre-check in at

- 14.2 Prior to the warning signal of her first race each day, a boat shall sail past the stern of the signal vessel, hail her sail number, and be acknowledged by the race committee.
- 14.2 [DP] A boat that retires from a race or does not intend to compete in a race after checking in shall notify the race committee as soon as possible.
- 14.3 [DP] All boats and support vessels shall comply with RRS 37 when flag V (white rectangle with red X) is displayed with 1 sound
